Topic: Containment Technology 101

Hari Floura, President of Floura LLC, Containment Consultants

Hari Floura is the President of Floura LLC. Mr. Floura has worked exclusively in the field of Containment Technology within the pharmaceutical industry. During this time, Hari Floura established and managed the USA offices of Applied Containment Engineering (ACE), in the position of President of Operations. In addition Hari has provided consultancy to many major Pharmaceutical Companies with respect to their containment guidelines and containment designs. He is also a member and presenter for ISPE and contributed to the ISPE Good Practice Guide – Assessing the Particulate Containment Performance of Pharmaceutical Equipment.

As more and more drug products are categorized as highly potent, companies have to quickly understand the needs associated with high risk/potent compounds and rapidly implement controls within tight budgets. Thus, selection and design of appropriate engineering controls to enable handling of high risk APIs has become critical with respect to both safety & cGMP.

Mr. Floura has spent his entire working career dealing with high risk/potent compound handling and will use this session to provide an overview of this subject. The following topics will be discussed:
